

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 28, 2000

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in regular session on Monday February 28, 2000 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor JP Wiles, Council Members Joann Norfleet, Clarence Floyd, G. Dear Mayor Wiles:

This letter is to commend 3 of your Somerset Firemen and 1 Somerst resident.

Our son, Jason Bowling, had a wreck in Sept. 1999 and is confined to a wheel chair. He came home on Feb. 11, 00.

Our house was not built with someone in a wheelchair in mind. Mike Phelps, Jerry Sutherland, David Volze and Robert Fitzgerald came in and built Jason a wheelchair ramp and a handicap bathroom.

These men donated their time, giving up their days off, bought things that was needed to do this job and went to some local building suppliers for some donations.

They worked some long hours to have this done before we brought Jason home, due to the time they said Jason could leave Cardinal Hill Rehab. Hospital and the day he came home.

Since Jason has been home, these 3 firemen and others including Lt. David Turpin have built him a metal stand to stand upright on. They found him a Hoyer lift to lift him up and down and kept looking until they found us a van equipped with a lift for his wheelchair.

Even though we don't live in the city limits, it makes me proud to know that we have this type of caring people to undertake to help someone. People that everyone in the city & county can be proud of. To us that is what makes Somerset & Pulaski County a great place to live.

We can never thank these Somerset firemen enough for everything that have done. With their help it has made it easier to do things with Jason.

Mayor Wiles I appreciate you taking your time in reading this. I just wanted you to know what great people & city employees you have in Somerset.

Mr. New moved to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held February 14, 200 and the reports as delivered. Mrs. Muse seconded the motion. Mr. Daughetee moved to authorize the Mayor to negotiate a contract with The Landplan Group in order for the city might get underway with its streetscape project. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion. Mr. Wilson moved to adopt a Resolution in support of Route 1-66 in or around Somerset. Mr.

Floyd seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted "Aye": Mr. Floyd, Mr. Wilson, Mr. Wheeldon, Mr. Daughette, Mr. new, Mr. Denham, Mr. Minton, Mr. Owens, Mr. Bourne, Mrs. Muse and Mrs. Norfleet.

Upon the recommendation of the Mayor, Mr. Owens moved to re-appoint Jim Dorsey and Tim Rutherford to two (2) year terms on the Parks Board. Mr. Floyd seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted "Aye": Mr. Floyd, Mr. Wilson, Mr. Wheeldon, Mr. Daughette, Mr. New, Mr. Denham, Mr. Minton, Mr. Owens, Mr. Bourne, Mrs. Muse and Mrs. Norfleet.
