A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF Somerset, Kentucky SUPPORTING THE MILLIONS IN A MONTH CAMPAIGN TO FIGHT HUNGER IN KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, nearly 20,000 people are homeless in Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, more than one in five children in Kentucky is living in poverty, and

WHEREAS, nearly one half of Kentucky's children live in families that are not financially self-sufficient,

WHEREAS, the majority of poor children live in urban areas, and

WHEREAS, hunger is a problem for many of these and other Kentuckians across the Commonwealth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF Somerset, KENTUCKY:

Section 1. That the City of Somerset joins Kentucky Harvest and the Kentucky League of Cities in support of the Millions in a Month campaign to fight hunger in Kentucky during the month of March, 2006.
