

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 12, 2018

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular meeting on Monday February 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Council Members; Brian Dalton, Jimmy Eastham, Jerry Girdler, Mike New, John Minton, Jim Mitchell, John Adams, Amanda Bullock, Tom Eastham and David Burdine and Mayor Eddie Girdler, City Attorney Carrie Weise and City Clerk Nick Bradley. Absent: Jerry Wheeldon and Donna Hunley.

Mr. New moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on January 22, 2017 along with reports as mailed. Mr. Dalton seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted "Aye": Mr. Dalton, Mr. J. Eastham, Mr. Girdler, Mr. New, Mr. Minton, Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Adams, Mrs. Bullock, Mr. T. Eastham, and Mr. Burdine.

Mr. J. Eastham moved to support the AMVET Riders for an event on May 19, 2018 that includes a motorcycle ride through Somerset carrying the POW flag by using the police department to escort the ride and the fire department to display an American Flag on a ladder truck. First reading was given the following Ord. No. 18-02: Amending Ord. No. 00-18 Ratifying the Schedule of Fees for Building Permits.

ORDINANCE NO. 18-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 00-18, KNOWN AS THE CITY'S ZONING ORDINANCE, SPECIFICALLY RATIFYING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR BUILDING PERMITS AS ADOPTED AND ENFORCED BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

1. Ordinance 00-18, Article VIII, Section 8.9, states that the Planning and Zoning Board shall recommend and enforce a schedule of rates for P&Z related fees. In addition, it also states that said schedule must be approved by the City Council. Although the P&Z Board approved an updated schedule for Building Permit Fees, there is no record showing that the City Council approved said updated schedule. Therefore, in order to have a record of compliance with our P&Z Ordinance, the Council herein adopts the schedule of Building Permit Fees as previously approved and herein recommended by the P&Z Board (see exhibit "A" attached hereto for the current Building Permit Fee schedule approved by the P&Z Board, incorporated in full herein by reference).
2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after adoption and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 18-01


AN ORDINANCE TO THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE CITY'S PERSONNEL POLICIES AS SET FORTH IN THE CITY EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

- (I) The City's Employee Handbook shall be amended in the following manner:
The attachment known as "Exhibit B - Drug Free Workplace Policy", as originally adopted in Ordinance 2015 is hereby repealed and replaced in full with the attached policy to be known hereafter as "Exhibit B - Drug and Alcohol Free Workplace Policy", said new policy as attached hereto to be incorporated in full herein by reference.
- (II) If any part of this ordinance is deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.
- (III) This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval, and publication according to law.


