Separate Sealed BIDS for the construction of Contract 1 - KY 80/KY 461 Gas Line Relocation and Contract 2 - KY 80/KY 461 Waterline & Sanitary Sewer Relocations, KYTC Item No. 8-59.25 & 8-59.26 will be received by the City of Somerset, 306 E. Mt Vernon Street, Somerset, KY 42501 until 2:00 P.M. local time, Thursday July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and then publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract 1 consists of relocating approximately 5,200 L.F. of 6" steel natural gas main, 780 L.F. of 4" HDPE gas main, 580 L.F. of 2" HDPE gas main, 585 L.F. of conventional bore and jack of 6" steel gas main, removal of 5,070 L.F. of existing gas main, and all other necessary appurtenances.

Contract 2 consists of approximately 2,036 L.F. of 16" D.I. waterline, 7,245 L.F. of 12" DI waterline, 543 L.F. of 8" PVC waterline, 2,050 L.F. of 6" PVC force main, 3,098 L.F. of 8" PVC gravity sewer, 151 L.F. of 24" encasement pipe (bore and jack), 384 L.F. of 20" encasement pipe (bore and jack), 416 L.F. of 16" encasement pipe (bore and jack), 151 L.F. of 12" encasement pipe (bore and jack), 17 manholes, and related appurtenances.

The apparent low bidder will be determined by adding the bid prices from Contract 1 and Contract 2 together. Any contractor that does not complete the bid schedules for both Contract 1 and Contract 2 will be considered non-responsive.

Each Bidder must accompany his/her bid with a Bid Bond in amount of not less than five (5) percent of the base bid for both Contract 1 & Contract 2. No Bidder may withdraw his/her bid for a period of 90 days. The Bidder awarded the contract shall execute a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond and shall furnish insurance as required, in the General Conditions, for both Contract 1 & Contract 2. Both Contract 1 & Contract 2 shall be completed within 130 calendar days after date of authorization to start work. Liquidated damages will be \$800 per calendar day for Contract 1 and will be \$300 per calendar day for Contract 2.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11246 and 11375, which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Section 3, Section 109, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Anti-Kickback Act and the contract Work Hours Standard Act. Bidders must certify that they do not, and will not, maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on a basis of race, color, creed, or national origin.

Any bid that is obviously unbalanced may be rejected. The City of Somerset reserves the right to reject any and all bids and waive informalities. A list of references will be requested and thoroughly reviewed. Small, minority and women's businesses and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to bid this project.
