## RESOLUTION 13-20 CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the Council has been informed that the State level ABC Office has not yet passed a regulation limiting the number of License Package (LP) licenses permitted within the corporate limits of the City of Somerset; and

WHEREAS, it is the City's understanding that it may request additional licenses to be made available in the City of Somerset in order to increase the total number of LP Quota licenses available to persons wishing to bring economic growth and development to Somerset and Pulaski County, provide new job opportunities, and create additional revenue for the use of the City of Somerset in the betterment of our community, and all other requirements as set forth in the City's ABC Ordinance, as well as any applicable state law and/or regulations;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and ordained by the Common Council of the City of Somerset that the Mayor shall have the authority to pursue actions necessary to advocate for additional LP Licenses to be made available to the City of Somerset, in order to better serve the citizens of Somerset, Pulaski County, surrounding Counties, and Lake Cumberland area travel and tourism increases existing both now, and in the immediate future.
